



RADIOLOGY

Process

- Volunteers should arrive by 4:45 am or 11:30 am and be ready to work by 5:15 am or 12:00 pm for shift 1 and 2 respectively.
- X-ray needs will be identified in Dental Triage. Please complete the imaging listed under the Imaging Required section of the patient form.
- Assure you complete the imaging section of all patient forms. There are multiple lines for x-rays as additional x-rays may be done in the clinical departments.
- Assure images are printed as well as digitally available for use by the clinic.
- Dexis software will be exclusively used in order to provide digital radiology through the clinic. We will be printing radiographs to have a redundant backup during the event as needed.

Triage dentists will seek to establish the chief complaint (s) or most urgent need (s) for each case. Triage will specify the area and what type of image should be taken. There should be separate lines for intraoral and pano x-rays. Each patient should go through radiology within 5 to 8 minutes. Please attempt to see 45 patients per shift at each station.
